### Home of the 2020 700 Club National Tournament

Hello again members! PLEASE read through carefully as there is a lot of information regarding club changes and additions!

**Club History:** In the 1955-56 bowling season seventeen (17) bowlers organized together with their main objective being an exclusive singles tournament for bowlers who had rolled a 700 series in league or tournament play. On May 3, 1956, the first tournament (which was a four-game event) was held at Twentieth Century Lanes and thus was the Ann Arbor 700 Club started. Last season we had 136 active members, including 15 new members, and held five tournaments including the 64<sup>th</sup> Annual Ernie Dieterle Singles Classic to honor the man who started our club.

#### Important Information

This past year saw our club hold the 64<sup>th</sup> Annual Ernie Dieterle Singles Classic with The Ann Arbor Women 600 Club Mary Hardy Singles. 66 people participated, a four bowler increase over the previous year. The Ann Arbor 700 Club will host the 2019 State Jamboree and the 2020 National 700 Club Tournament. The State Jamboree will be October 26<sup>th</sup> at Lodge Lanes and the 2020 National 700 Club Tournament will be at Lodge Lanes on May 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>. There will also be a golf outing on May 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Elections:** Elections will be held before the Singles Tournament in January. Daryl Moore is the King Pin. Tom Shereda is the Prince Pin. Joe Andrusiak is Pin Buoy. Richard Payne is the La Guardia Pin. Ron Clement, Richard Smith and Sherri Carter are the Foul Judges. If you would like to participate on the board, please see Joe Andrusiak for more details. If you have any questions about our tournaments please see one of these board members.

**Dues: \$5.00 per member.** These can be paid when you see any one of the above directors, or you can mail it to: **Ann Arbor 700 Club, P.O. Box 576, Belleville, MI 48112. NOTE: Lifetime membership (no local dues) is granted to those members age 65 or older as of September 1, 2019.** Please don't send dues to any other 700 Club.

**Fines:** If you shoot a game of 260 or better and fail to reach a 700 series you, as a club member, shall have incurred a fine of \$1. Should you shoot 260+ and fail to reach a 600 series, the fine shall be \$2. It's all done on the honor system. So when it happens to you please just roll with it and give a George Washington or two to a club officer. **Also, if you fail to wear your club shirt to any event it will cost you a Lincoln (\$5).**

**Shirts:** The price of the club shirts is \$40 (additional for 2X+ sizes). Bowlers can select male or female styles as well as various name options. Order forms can be found on the club website or picked up at a tournament.

**Club funds:** The bank balance as of May 31, 2019: \$3306.90. Club funds are used to pay honor score prizes at our tournaments, maintain the website and provide this annual mailing.

**Membership:** As of May 31, 2019 we have a paid up membership of 109 men and women, with an additional 27 active Lifetime Members. If you know a former member who has become inactive urge them to enter the next tournament. **To become active again will cost only \$10 in dues!!!**

**Honor Score Prize:** For the past ten years we have paid out a \$50 club prize for any Ann Arbor 700 Club member shooting a 300 game or 800 series in one of the club sponsored tournaments. This will continue for the 2019-2020 season.

**\*\*\*IMPORTANT TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:** The first tournament is a trio team tournament with each team requiring at least one active 700 Club member. If you know of someone interested in our club and they have bowled the required 700 scratch series in a certified league, ask them to participate and see what we are about.
